## Updates to CDE's as of Summer Conference 2022

## **General Rules**

- 1. 2020 exams will be eliminated from the list of possible exams on CDE's that use previous years' tests as a resource.
- 2. Cell phones, smart watches, and all other electronic devices are not allowed in any CDE.

### Ag Ed CDE

- 1. Invitational at State CDE's Summer 2023.
- 2. Invitational rules coming from Clara-Leigh

### Agronomy

- 1. A list of prohibited and restrictive weeds will be added to the CDE resource email and sent out prior to CDE's.
- 2. Necrosis was removed from plant disorder and disease list.
- 3. Scab or wilt on grain seed heads will not be used since they look the same.
- 4. Weeds of any stage was removed.
- 5. Fixed fertilizer card so points add up to 100

## **Conduct of Chapter Meetings**

- 1. Conduct of Chapter Meetings LDE include a semi-final and final round at the state event.
- 2. CCM will be broken into two flights for the semi-final round at state and the teams will be placed in flights based on their test scores. Flight #1 includes 1-4-5-8-9 and Flight #2 includes 2-3-6-7-10. Top 2 teams from each flight will advance to the finals and their test scores follow them through the event.

## **Environmental and Natural Resources**

- 1. Remove Binoculars from ID list
- 2. Add the following items to the ID list:

Water Quality

-Turbidity Tube

Wildlife

-River Otter and Pine Martin

Birds

-Crow, Raven, Pintail Duck, and Magpie

Fish

-Mountain Whitefish, Yellow Perch, and Kokanee Salmon

Plants

- -Big Sagebrush, Arrowleaf Balsamroot, Bluebunch Wheatgrass, Coyote Willow, Nebraska Sedge, Smooth Bromegrass, Downy Bromegrass (Cheatgrass), Rabbitbrush (either rubber or green rabbitbrush), Antelope Bitterbrush, Baltic Rush. Invasive
- -Asiatic Clams
- 3. Water analysis revisions to reflect current practices in the field. Dr. Wilhelm, UI Limnologist, will develop guidelines for testing and provide turbidity parameters, range, and expected standards.
- 4. The following categories will be tested each year: pH, dissolved oxygen, turbidity, and temperature (Turbidity is being substituted for nitrates in the current version of this practicum).
- 5. Test results for each of the 4 water quality attributes will be worth 10 points each.
- 6. "Effect on Environment" changed to "Effects on Specific Setting" which will be outlined at the site.
- 7. Three questions on score card (Effect on specific setting, limiting factors, and how can water quality be improved?) will be worth 20 points each (No changed to point value).
- 8. Tools and resources needed (will be provided at the event):
- -Hach pH meter, Carolina Turbidity Tube (Field Master), and Thermometer.

### **Food Science**

1. Corrected numbering issues and made scores match as per the rules.

#### **Horse Evaluation**

1. All halter classes will be judged as sound.

#### <u>Livestock Evaluation</u>

1. Oral reasons will be given at the end of the contest and not during a rotation.

#### Milk Quality and Products

- 1. Dairy vs. Non Dairy changed to Natural vs. Imitation
- 2. Almond, Oat, Rice, etc. added to dairy non dairy section.

#### **Nursery Landscape**

- 1. Remove the following species from ID list:
- -White Fir, Spreading Cotoneaster, and White Ash
- 2. Add the following species to the ID list:
- -Butterfly Bush, Coral Bells (Alumroot), Black-Eyed Susan, English Lavender, Easter White Pine, Sweet Gum, Clematis, Tuliptree, Bigleaf Hydrangea, and Rhododendron.
- 3. Changed equipment and supply list to be the same as nationals.
- 4. Added 5 beneficial insects from national list to ID.

#### **Parliamentary Procedure**

1. Parli will be broken into two flights for the semi-final round at state and the teams will be placed in flights based on their test scores. Flight #1 includes 1-4-5-8-9 and Flight #2

includes 2-3-6-7-10. Top 2 teams from each flight will advance to the finals and their test scores follow them through the event.

- 1. Made an official Idaho FFA event starting in 2023.
- 2. Participants may not bring any printed or written material to the event.
- 3. Added 2 more placing classes for a total of 4.
